


2 19 NOVEMBER 2022

The Commerce department organized a 3 Day Workshop on 'Income Tax and Efiling'. The resource person of the workshop was Ms. Heena Mahajan, (Chartered Accountant) one of our Alumnae.

On Day 1, processing of application for PAN card was discussed thoroughly. Before proceeding further, she discussed about the official site of income tax department i.e., eportal.gov. in. Then she discussed about Form 15G and 15 H in detail. Afterwards the difference between both the forms was discussed with examples.

On Day 2, Form 26 AIS (Annual Information Statement) was discussed. AIS is a comprehensive view of information for a taxpayer displayed in Form 26AS. Taxpayer can provide feedback on information displayed in AIS. It shows both reported value and modified value (i.e., value after considering taxpayer feedback) under each section. In the end, e-pay tax (challans) was also discussed.

On day 3, two return forms 24Q and 26Q were discussed.

70 students of the department attended this workshop.
