Clubs & Committees: Co-curricular activity plays a vital role to enhance the quality of education in the institution. The college have various Clubs & Committees such as NSS, Rotaract Club, Enactus Club, Science Club, Youth Welfare Club, Red Ribbon Club, Health Club, Women Cell, Advance Learner Club, Electoral Literacy Club, Environment Association, Central Association, Alumni Association, Open Mike Club, BYAS(Books You & Silence), Competitive Cell, Red Ribbon Club, Red Cross Society and Health Club, Sports Club, I.T Club, Patriotic Club, Examination Committee, Admission Committee, Advisory Committee, Think Tank, and Cafeteria Committee etc..

The NSS wing of the college organized 7 days camp. 20 volunteers took part in this camp enthusiastically. In these 7 days, NSS volunteers performed various activities like Cleaning Campaign, Nutritious diet, Techniques of making domestic items from old and new clothes, hair do, nail art, facial beauty tips, visits to villages- Janda, Amipur, Sangatpur respectively. Menstrual Hygiene Survey was the prominent features of this camp.

In Zonal Youth festival, our students brought laurels for college by bagging 2^{ndt} position inGiddha, Elocution and Photography, 3rd position in Quiz Competition.

During this session total 7 Inter- College and Inter- Class Competitions were attended by our college students. Students of Science department participated in an event'Science Fiesta', 2019 organized by Doaba College, Jalandhar and got Appreciation Award in Scientoon and Poster Making respectively. Our Quiz team got second prize with cash prize reward of Rs. 3000/- while in declamation got 3rd prize. Punjabi department organized Inter- College Quiz competition to celebrate International Mother Language Day in which 96 students from 12 colleges participated with full zest. Besides, these competitions our student participated in Declamation Competition held at PrasthanAsharam on the eve of Vinobha bhave Jayanti and bagged 1st position.
