Pt. Mohan Lal S.D College for Women, Gurdaspur stands tall as an elite institution in the arena of education in Punjab. The college is an excellent model of what a women college does for women's development. The college has steadily shown its potential in academics, curricular and co-curricular activities. The college is committed to the empowerment of women through value based education as well as integrated learning. Apart from integrating value of education into main curriculum, motivational talks, leadership programs and counseling sessions are conducted for holistic development of students.

The vision of the college is to emerge as a 'premier institution' to empower women through holistic education. The college is situated in 2.5 acres and has a superbly designed building. The surrounding creates a tranquil atmosphere that is ideal for intellectual pursuits. The college has beautiful vigorous green lawns. There are total 21 well-furnished and upgraded classrooms and 10 Smart classrooms to facilitate teaching through modern tools and techniques. Besides this, the college has 18 well equipped Laboratories, a state-of-the-art Seminar Hall which is centrally air conditioned, 1 student Centre and Cafeteria. The College has various facilities to address the reading, hearing and understanding requirements of various students. The college library is an empowering unit possessing an array of books to assist in the process of self actualization. In this academic session, many books for different subjects and journals (Economic and Political Weekly, Third Concept, Indian Journal of Finance, Main Stream, Indian Textile Journal, Indian Journal of Economics and Research, Gyanm, Dialog) have been added to the already existing stock. The computerized library has been given free internet access and access to DELNET and INFLIBNET e-resources, which satisfies the curious minds' need to delve into uncharted territory of knowledge. The college has a high-speed Internet connection that supports Wi-Fi. The College is endowed with renovated hostel, modern gymnasium, a huge parking facility (available to both students and faculty) and 3 playgrounds. A complete smoke and vehicle free zone, the College provides an eco-friendly environment to its students with the latest initiatives of solar panel and other green initiatives. The College has taken measures to address the need for vigilance and security. The campus is CCTV-enabled to cater the safety requirements of a well endowed and equipped campus receiving a huge footfall.

The college curriculum consists of a variety of changing and advanced programmes to give students the necessary information to adapt to environment. The college is offering a wide range of curriculum programmes in Arts, Science, Computer, Fashion Designing and Commerce. The college is offering courses like B.A, B.A (Honours Eng, Pol. Sci.), BCA, B.Com, B.Sc. (Med/

Non-Med.), B.Sc. (Computer Science), B.Sc.(Economics), B.Sc. (Fashion Designing) besides successfully running M.Sc.(Computer Science), M.Sc. (Fashion Designing), M.Com & M.A (Punjabi). The skill based academic programmes like PG Diploma in Computer Application, UG Diploma in Stitching & Tailoring and UG Diploma in Cosmetology are running successfully. In spite of these courses, the college commenced 7 Add- On Courses, Short term Courses and also arranged bridge, remedial and advance learner classes.
