

SERIES OF WEBINARS AND SEMINARS







The English department of the College organized a webinar on the topic 'The Romantic Imagination of the British Romantic Poets: An introduction.' Dr. Dhurba Jyoti Malakar Assistant Professor, PUB Bongsor College, Guwahati was the keynote speaker.
