IQAC in association with Fashion Designing and Cosmetology department organized two days exhibition to showcase the talent and entrepreneur skills of the students under 'Learn and Earn' scheme. In the exhibition, students put up Student Handicraft Shop (SHS corner) and exhibited their talent through myriad stalls on tie and die, block printing, screen printing, utility items, apparel accessories, scarves, stoles, wall hangings, dupattas, mirrors, jewellery, decorative thalis and various handicrafts. Staff and students visited the stalls and purchased the items. A workshop on 'Professional Makeup and Advance Hair Cut' was organized by the Cosmetology department. Famous Makeup artists Ms. Suchita and Mr. Siddharth Dhiman from the Sabir Academy and Salon were the resource persons. Mr. Siddharth gave a demonstration of basic and advance haircuts. Ms. Suchita gave details about basic and advance make up. The participants were given practical training. The purpose of organizing such seminars and workshops is to enhance their learning skills beyond classroom learning.
