Celebration Activity Cell of the Institution Innovation Council of the college in collaboration with Ministry of Education celebrated "WORLD TECHNOLOGY DAY". A visit to Punjab Agriculture University Centre, Gurdaspur was planned. A group of 15 students along with teacher incharge visited University for learning the new techniques and methods used in agricultural farming in today's developing world. Students gained knowledge about different farming methods. Dr. Vivek Pandey from Agriculture University briefly explained about the importance and need of soilless farming. They also visited Soil testing Laboratory where Dr. Gayatri Verma introduced students with the soil testing methods and equipments. She taught students that soil test can determine fertility or the expected growth potential of the soil. Dr. H.S Randhawa emphasized on the main preference to physical agents because it is eco-friendly and less costly as compared to the other methods. An inter class quiz competition was organized by Social Media Cell of IIC of the college on the theme "India's Presidency Under G-20".
