FDP for Staff

IQAC of Pt. MLSD College organized a guest lecture on 'Preparedness for NEP 2020 in colleges' in which Prof. Dr. Rajesh Kumar, Dept. of Social Sciences, GNDU, Amritsar was the guest speaker. He apprised that, all Indian HEIs will be expected to achieve a number of milestones to ensure they are fully prepared for the rollout of NEP 2020. He elaborated that it is important to develop a multidisciplinary approach in order to be better prepared for NEP 2020. Faculty members from different departments need to work together and share their knowledge and expertise in order to come up with a comprehensive plan that will address all aspects of the challenge. The goal is to develop a holistic approach that takes into account the unique needs of every institute. He suggested outlining the institution's strategy for providing a flexible, multidisciplinary curriculum that allows for different entry points and exits at the conclusion of the first, second, and third years of undergraduate study and also for research work in fourth year. He recommended to introduce vocational programs and community college programs apart from regular programs under the Choice Based Credit Semester System. He further suggested for seamless collaborations, internationalization of education, joint degrees between Indian and foreign institutions, and to enable credit transfer through ABC credit system.

PDP for Students

The college organised three days Personality Development Programme to enhance the personality of the students. The motive of this programme was to boost student's confidence, instill self-esteem and helps in grooming their personality. On the first day, Er. Surkhab Shelly and Er.
